ARRIVAL TIME

You are welcome to arrive anytime from 6.00pm onwards but have dinner before you come. The first activity starts at 7.15pm.

You will be welcomed by **Sandy Radford** who will be seated at the outdoor table under the veranda outside the main dining room. She will direct you to where your allocated cabin is. We aim to keep families together in separate cabins depending on how many we have coming to camp. There are youth cabins for boys and girls and also older adult male and female cabins. There are several men's and women's shower and toilet blocks. You can bring your own tent if you prefer. If so can you please let Sandy or Joss know.

CAMP PROGRAMME

The programme will be up on the Lifezone website and up on the noticeboard at Camp (there may be a few final minor adjustments in final version at camp).

One of these is the **Glow Worm Boat Trip** which heads out at 9.00pm. This is a fantastic boat trip down the river to a spot which has loads of glowworms - it is quite magical. You **MUST** sign up for this so we can try to make sure everyone who wants to go is able to - on either Friday or Saturday night. There will be a sign up form on the notice board in the dining room so please put your name down on Friday night if you are keen.

FOOD BELL

When you hear the bell ring at camp it means come to the dining room (generally for food) but also to meet for the next activity or teaching session.

POOL AND WATER ACTIVITIES

We need two designated pool supervisors pool side at all times that children are in the pool. We expect that all parents who have children swimming in the pool at camp will volunteer to be a supervisor for a couple of hours over the weekend.

Pool supervisors are required to be present by the camp management whenever kids are in the pool so this job needs to be shared around. Parents do need to be aware there are lots of water activities at camp and need to be responsible for and aware of their children's safety.

ROSTERS

There will be a roster this year. You can expect to be on something once over camp eg: setting up dining room tables, cooks dishes etc. PLEASE turn up to your job when rostered on.

SUNDAY CLEAN UP

We all chip in together for the end of camp clean up on Sunday afternoon.

WHAT TO BRING**BEDDING**

There is a mattress supplied in the cabins but you need to bring pillow, sheets, blankets, sleeping bag etc..

BIBLE AND NOTEPAD**BAKING**

From each family please. This provides us with our yummy morning, afternoon teas and supper.

FRUIT OR VEGES

If you have excess from your garden such as apples, tomatoes, avocados etc.. please bring them. This is most appreciated at camp.

CLOTHING AND TOILETRIES

Warm gear for evenings and Glowworms trip, togs, towels, wetsuits (if you have them), sunhat, sun block, insect repellent etc...

A little extra \$. There will be real coffee available at set times. Cost will be \$3 per coffee.
